Teacher

1. The teacher works directly and effectively with identified elementary or secondary talented and gifted students.
2. The teacher pursues ongoing professional development in the field of TAG education: graduate courses, workshops, conferences, etc.
3. The teacher demonstrates peer leadership in TAG education: providing professional development, writing curriculum, leading co-curricular or community outreach activities.

TAG Coordinator

1. The coordinator has made significant contributions to expanding and improving programs and services for talented and gifted students in the school.
2. The coordinator has shown leadership in talented and gifted education at the county, state and/or national level.

School Administrator

1. The Administrator shows leadership in expanding/improving programs and services for talented and gifted students in the school or school system.
2. The Administrator allocates resources (time, people, money) to expand and improve talented and gifted education programs and services.
3. The Administrator leads the expansion/improvement of parent, community, and/or business partnerships that directly support the education of talented and gifted students.
